

## Cookies Policy for Terrafirma

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers (small piece of data) that we store on your browser (e.g., Google Chrome) or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. It consists of anonymous information, as well as a unique user identifier. When you revisit a site or navigate between pages, this data is passed from your browser to the site's server. With this data, the website is able to 'remember' your browser, enabling it to retrieve your user preferences, to personalise your visits and to simplify any sign-in procedures.

Cookies are intended to improve your user experience by making it easier and faster to navigate through a website. All of the information a cookie collects can only be retrieved by the website server that sent the cookie to your browser.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.**

These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.

- **Analytical/performance cookies.**

They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

- **Functionality cookies.**

These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

- **Targeting cookies.**

These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

- **Third party cookies** are cookies that are set by a domain other than the one being visited by the user. For details of any third-party cookies we include in our domain, please consult the table below.

Most web browsers allow some control of most cookies through the browser settings. Cookie	Duration	Purpose
_ga	Two years	Used to distinguish users.
_gat	1 minute	Used to throttle request rate.
_gid	24 hours	Used to distinguish users
Phpsessid	Session	Session identifier for website code operation and store serialised state data. Used to establish a user session and pass state data.
JSESSIONID	Session	JSESSIONID is an ID generated by Servlet container and used for session management in J2EE web application for http protocol. The ID is sent to the client either within a cookie (default) or as part of the URL (called URL rewriting, used only if cookies are disabled on the browser).
Cookie preference (cookieaccept)	Session	This cookie is used to remember a user's acknowledgement of cookies on the website.
Google Analytics _utma _utmb _utmc _utmz	Two years Session Cookie Not set Six months	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site. Localisation	Session	This is used by the website content management systems to keep track of the local time zone.
NID	Session	This is a third-party cookie used by Google for tracking the number of people that are using Google's maps application. Google's maps are used on the contact us and location page.
